The school has a responsibility to ensure the Health and Safety of all our pupils and workers (whilst working on or off the dance school premises). We will endeavour to provide, as far as is reasonably practicable, a working environment that is safe and with minimum risk to workers (including self-employed), students, visitors and members of the public. Arrangements for health and safety - our risk assessment.

- We will always complete relevant risk assessment and put in place controls to avoid or reduce risk as far as is reasonably practicable.
- We will review our risk assessment when there is a change.
- We will consult routinely on health and safety matters with workers, pupils and people impacted as they arise and or as a result of a review of health and safety risk.
